

FACILITY USE STANDARDS FOR ILLUMINATION DANCE COMPANY AUDITIONS/REHEARSALS

- 1. Please refrain from running, playing ball, or shouting in courtyard, as well as keeping out of the large concrete planters. Remember that the courtyard is for quiet enjoyment. There are other residents who run their businesses here and we need to be community members that will add to the serenity and calm feel of Washougal Town Square.
- 2. In order to show proper respect to our choreographers who give of their time freely, being on time to rehearsals is imperative. You must also bring a water bottle with you. There is a water fountain in the lobby for the refilling of water bottles.
- 3. Please do not touch the walls, mirrors, or windows in the studios. Dancers who are caught touching walls, mirrors, or windows will be kept after rehearsals by choreographers to clean.
- 4. There is no food or drink in the studio. Water is okay. Please eat at the table or counter in the lobby. When you are done eating, please pick up and discard trash.
- 5. The lobby is for customers, not for loitering. If you are not in rehearsal, then you should not be at the studio. The lobby will not be a hang-out or a baby-sitting area for siblings or friends that are not company members.
- 6. Retail dance wear that is for sale is not to be touched without the assistance of Sarah Dayley.
- 7. Last but not least, the back dressing room is a place to change, not to hang out. Please DO NOT EAT OR DRINK in the back dressing room. Keep your items in the cubby spaces provided. Lost and found items will be taken monthly to be donated, so please do not leave your items behind.

If we all follow the same standard of care for the facility that we use free of charge, we will continue to be able to use these lovely spaces. We want this to be a great season, so please abide by the rules and we will all have a wonderful time together! I have read all of the above rules and agree to comply as a contracted dancer for IDC.
